- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI, given that the transcript form and all relevant course work documents have been submitted by the student.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the Inter institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

1.Grading systems of the Institution

Universidad Isabel I: our grading system is based on continuous assessment (up to 60% of the final mark) and an end-of-course exam (from 40% of the final mark). Continuous assessment grades will be obtained through the various online assignments to be completed during the course. The end-of-course exam is face-to-face. It will take place at the end of the course. A minimum mark of 4 in the exam is required to apply the continuous assessment + exam formula. Any mark below 4 at

the exam will be a fail in the course, regardless of the grade obtained in continuous assessment. All marks will be awarded on a 10-point scale:
